Skills Test

- · Testing details:
 - Test each student for high-quality BLS and bag-mask ventilation with OPA/NPA insertion
 - Test each student with a team (at least 3 students) for Megacode
 - Student must demonstrate the entire sequence for high-quality BLS, bag-mask ventilation with OPA/NPA insertion, and Megacode without instructor prompting
 - Carefully observe the student as he or she is being tested
 - Do not coach or give hints during the test
 - Fill out the High-Quality BLS, Airway Management, and Megacode Skills Testing Checklists
 - Refer the student for remediation if the test is unsuccessful
- If necessary, retest student(s) 1 additional time; if a student does not pass the test the second time, refer him or her for remediation
